## RULES AND PROCEDURES



Welcome! This event is sanctioned by KCBS (Kansas City Barbecue Society) with official rules available at <http://www.kcbs.us> Please read these rules to prevent unfortunate disqualifications. All KCBS Rules apply to competition meats.

- “First come; first served” at this “Rain or Shine” event. Sorry; no refunds.
- Registrations postmarked **on or after August 1<sup>st</sup>** require a \$225 ENTRY FEE to participate.
- Grand and Reserve Champion competitors must compete in all four categories.
- Second Round of the Top Ten Rib-Eye Steak teams will receive three Rib-Eye Steaks from Omaha Steaks to cook for the final round on Saturday.
- **This is a four-category contest with three ancillaries: Rib-Eye Steak, Side Dish, & Dessert.**
  - ***Side dishes and Desserts must be prepared on site.***
  - ***Peoples Choice on Sunday before contest – turn in by 11 a.m.***
- *RV plumbing is not available on site. Access to water is available on site. Portable restrooms will be located near contest areas.*
- *Recreational Vehicle (RV) power is unavailable. Please bring a generator, if needed.*
- Electric hook-ups are free for up to 20 amps and 30 amps. Please bring your own **200'** heavy duty extension cord. **Electricity will be unavailable after midnight on Sunday. (If you want 30 amps you need to put it on your application.)**
- **Bring a fire extinguisher** for your area. Metal cans for dumping hot ashes will be available.
